HOW?

Record before your action

In a notebook or google doc or sheet record your initiative before you take action, calculate normal GHG use or normal streets. Take pictures if you can!

Take Action! Make sure to record what you do in a notebook, with photos and/or video.

Do your action or project! Measure the impact, track how it is going and reflect on how the project went. We encourage you to take pictures, video or make a infographic for our report.

5

Submit your final Project April 10, 2022

You will submit their project in google form by writing a report and building a poster on how they tracked and measured their GHG reduction. The report will include: What you did, How you did it and a reflection on your project's impacts on the global climate movement.
